Introduction

These release notes describe one change made to the Trimble® Infrastructure NetRS receiver firmware. With this release, the receiver can use version 1.3-1 firmware.

To use firmware version 1.3-1, the receiver must have a valid firmware warranty dated 10 December 2010 or later. If necessary, contact your Trimble reseller to purchase a warranty.

Before you perform a firmware upgrade, Trimble recommends that you download and back up any files that are on the receiver.

If your Trimble receiver is supplied with additional Trimble firmware or software, upgrade those items to the latest version *before* you install firmware version 1.3-1.

Resolved issue

This firmware release resolves one specific issue.

Previous firmware versions exhibited the potential for a system counter to reset the receiver approximately every seven years. This firmware release prevents any such future occurrences.

Upgrading the firmware

1. Make sure that the receiver firmware warranty date is 10 December 2010 or later and that the receiver has sufficient free memory to upload the firmware file.
2. Use the NetRS browser interface to upload the firmware file onto the NetRS receiver.
3. Click **Install**.

The installation process will take several minutes.
